Alpha Family Features: how the liners differ

There are three main points of difference among the liner family: Interface Type, Body Fabric, and Profile

			
Interface Type:	Classic Gel	Hybrid Gel	Silicone
Body Fabric:	Original Spirit MAX	Select	Select
Profile:	Uniform Tapered Contoured AK Profile	Uniform Progressive AK (Symmetrical)	Progressive

The liner interface materials each respond differently to pressure. Clinicians must consider the needs of their patients when determining which interface type is most appropriate.
